#### **Section A: Dancing**

## 1. Two-Stepping Competition

- Music will be supplied and each dance competition will require contestants to dance the duration of a two songs minimum
- A maximum of two couples from each club may enter

#### 2. Line Dancing Competition

- Each club is entitled to one entry in this competition
- All competitors will simultaneously line dance to the same song
- Competitors are asked to review the standard line dance routines for the following potential songs
  - Good Times Alan Jackson
  - Footloose Footloose (2011) movie

#### **Section B: Music**

- \* Each Club may enter up to 2 entries in each category
- \* Each entry will be required to prepare one song, maximum of 5 minutes
- \* Instrumental/musical accompaniment will be permitted, but must be provided by the club. If using recorded music, lyrics must not be audible.
- \* For the instrumental competition, sheet music must be presented to the judges prior to performing, and it is also allowed on stage.

- 5. Instrumental Solo any instrument, must provide your own instruments

# 1. Impromptu Public Speaking Competition

- Entrants will draw a topic/item in a random fashion
- Entrants will be given 30 seconds to prepare
- The entrants will have 1 minute to talk about their selected topic/item
- Judging will be marked on creativity, clarity of thought, delivery, and effectiveness
- Each entrant is able to redraw topics <u>one</u> time

#### 2. Spelling Bee

• Entrants will be allowed to ask for a definition and/or for the word to be used in a sentence

#### 3. Mystery Event

- Only one entry per club
- Work collaboratively with your club to think on your feet and create during this mystery event

- This competition will run like a traditional Gong Show, and contestants will be gonged off the stage at the judge's discretion
- The winner of the Gong Show will show off their Gong Show talents at the banquet, as part of the Entertainment Showcase
- All entries in the Gong Show must be appropriate for all ages. Inappropriate entries will be disqualified
