- Each club is eligible to enter more than one team, unless otherwise stated by the organizing committee.
- All participants must be a JFAO member in good standing. Membership validity will be checked during registration. Clubs owing any money or information to JFAO will not be allowed to participate until all invoices are paid and information is submitted.
- As per JFAO policy, any members signing up on the day of the event will be charged an additional \$5.00 fee per person.
- Winter Games is an alcohol and cannabis free event, as per JFAO policy.  
The club of any participant found in possession of alcohol or cannabis will be subject to a fine of \$100.00 for a first offence and \$250.00 for a second offence.
- Participants are reminded to read the JFAO Policies including 14 (9) Sexual Harassment Policy
- The organizing committee has the final say regarding all the rules, scheduling, and winners.
- All sporting events are included in the price of team admission, individual registrants may join with a club on the day of the event.
- Results of the games will be announced during the Evening Event or the end of the day.
- All participants must sign a waiver before participating in the event.
- Participants under 18 years of age must have a waiver signed by a parent or guardian.

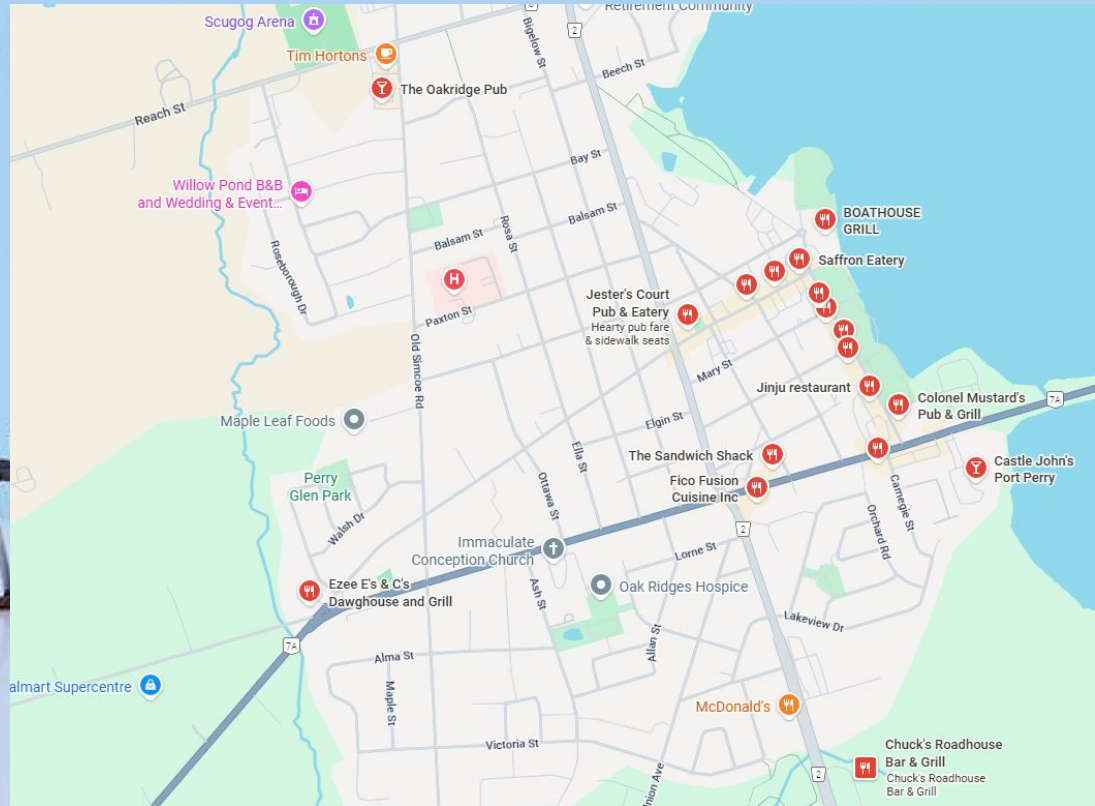
